In the recent PHASA newsletter (Professional Hunting Association of South Africa) the following false information was published regarding the True Green Alliance (TGA) and CPHC-SA. As quoted: "TGA refuses to support 'The custodians', PHASA's breakaway group, because they supported the Blood Lion Film produced by a commercial animal activist association that has links with international anti-hunting organisations. The custodian group is threatening court action against TGA". They deemed fit to publish such without any form of due diligence towards CPHC-SA or requesting any sort of verification to the report.

CPHC-SA refutes in the strongest terms these false allegations and neither has CPHC-SA threatened legal action against TGA as stated in the newsletter.
